


# what's NEW

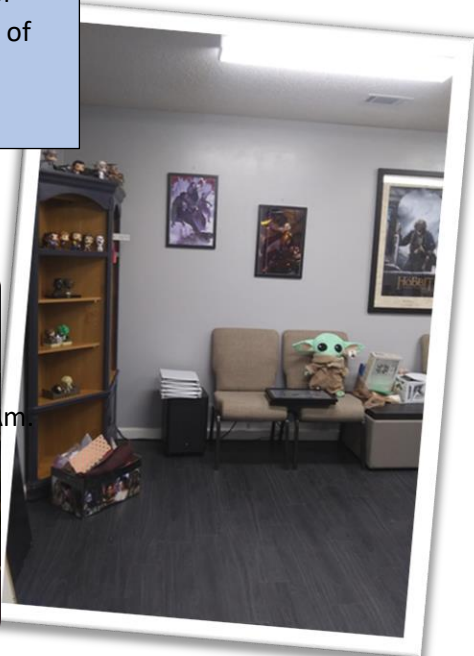
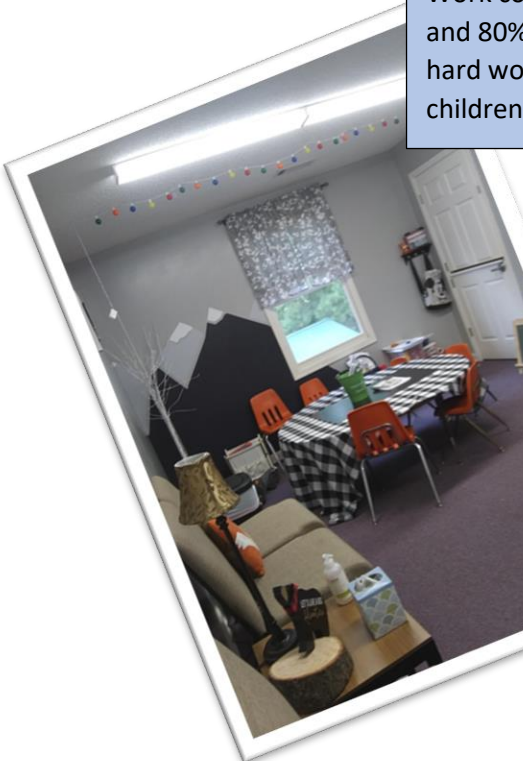

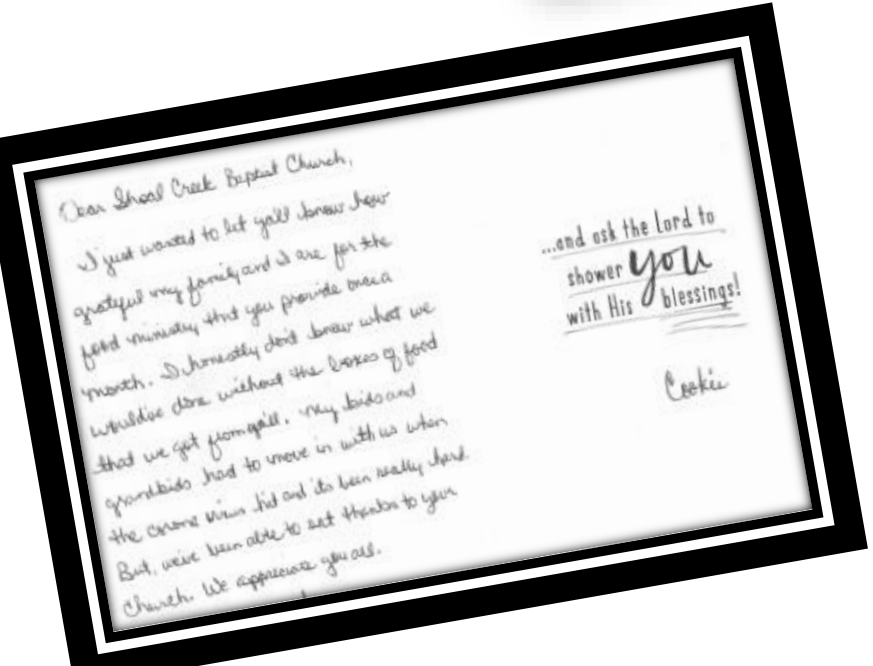
## Men's Bible Study
